Dear Friends of BRHA,

As we wrap up 2024, we want to share what an amazing year it's been! Thanks to our fantastic board, staff, and dedicated volunteers, we've accomplished so much and are excited to keep making a difference for the animals and people in our community. Here are some highlights from this year:

- • We held our first-ever 24-hour Slumber Party at the shelter—it was such a unique and successful experience. We are planning on doing it again in 2025.
- We launched "The Howling," our fun Halloween Ball, to celebrate our work and the amazing people who support us. It was a huge accomplishment, so stay tuned for the second, annual event next Fall.
- We offered free microchips and I.D. tags to all pet owners who needed one. Our success rate in reuniting lost animals with their families has been breaking all sorts of records. Getting lost pets home makes everyone happy.
- We held a vaccine clinic with Petco Love and the Humane Society of Western Montana. Grants have allowed us to continue offering free, preventative vaccines for cats and dogs, keeping our community pets healthy.
- We launched our first spay and neuter clinic for community owned animals, offering a service that is often unaffordable for many. We intend to make this a monthly service throughout the coming year.
- Our Pet Food Pantry continues to be a service benefiting community members and their pets. By offering free food and supplies, we can ensure pets stay with their families and not surrendered to a shelter.
- Our shelter is now open 7 days a week, a real plus for anyone wanting to adopt or look for a lost pet.

We're proud of what we've done, and we hope you are, too!

We rely entirely on donations—receiving no government subsidy, so we're asking for your support to continue our work. Our community focus ensures that people and their pets get what they need to stay together. Taking care of both ends of the leash is one of our priorities. Your donation, however big or small, is guaranteed to help the animals we all care so much about. Thank you for making this all possible! 
